"THANKFUL BEYOND WORDS!"

Thanksgiving arrived a few weeks early for the seniors living in the White Mountain Villas in Show Low! Last Friday, Arleen and Mike Caruth delivered 32 Thanksgiving boxes of food plus turkeys and turkey breasts and an assortment of other foodstuffs all of which had been donated by our generous parishioners.

You may remember, during the summer, the <u>White Mountain</u> <u>Independent</u> ran a front page article about the fact that the White Mountain Villas maintained a food pantry to be used by any of their seniors living on fixed incomes who need food donations to keep from going hungry. This pantry is also used to feed some of the homeless living near Walmart and in the general vicinity of the White Mountain Villas.

Arleen states the food donated last Friday will feed more than 100 people because the Villas are hosting a Thanksgiving dinner in addition to providing food boxes to those unable to attend the Thanksgiving meal.

Arleen reports that the folks at the pantry were "thankful beyond words" for the generosity extended to them by the parishioners of St Mary of the Angels Catholic Church!

By the time Arleen and Mike drove away, the pantry was full!

The remaining 30 Thanksgiving baskets will be donated to White Mountain Catholic Charities and to our sister organization at the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

A huge "thank you" to all of our parishioners who so willingly contributed to the Thanksgiving food drive this year. As you know, there is need in every community but it is wonderful to have such supportive parishioners to be part of the solution!

Please note, new positions will be effective on January 1, 2023.

SHOULD YOU ATTEND VIRTUS TRAINING?

VIRTUS Training will be in the Church Overflow Hall on Saturday, November 19th, at 8:00am. This training is **MANDATORY** for Church Employees, Youth Chaperones, Religious Education Teachers, Madonna Guild president & vice president, Knights of Columbus Members Officers, and Lay Ministers who have contact with children or vulnerable adults.

Lay Ministers (Lectors/Ushers/Eucharistic Ministers/Volunteers and Madonna members), if you do not have any contact with children, youth, or vulnerable adults in our Parish, you are not required to attend the training. We do, however, need you to sign and return to the office the **Code of Ethics Acknowledgement Form** prior to being scheduled for any Lay Minister assignments in December. Madonna members who work at the Halloween Party, Junior League Luncheon or help with Confirmation/1st Communion celebrations should complete and return the Code of Ethics Acknowledgement Form but not attend the training. 
