# **MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN 2022**

As your president this year, I am humbled by your hard work and dedication! This year you have contributed so much to all the ministries of the Madonna Guild. Let's examine the numbers.

The Rosary Ministry sent out 2,600 rosaries to Nigeria, Dominican Republic, Venezuela and to a prison ministry in Arizona. The Prayer Shawl Ministry crocheted more than 125 prayer shawls and lap robes as well as over 80 pocket prayer shawls.

The Book Studies Ministry brought new meaning to our relationship with Jesus via 6 book/video studies that ran throughout the year. The Blood Drive Ministry will help almost 200 people with the blood collected at the 2 blood drives this year.

The Social Activities Ministry hosted 2 Meet & Greet Socials as well as a fabulous English Tea send off for our summer Visitors. The Prayer Line Ministry prayed throughout the year for those suffering from illness, injury or the death of a loved one.


Our Fundraising Ministry held a phenomenal bake sale at the Run To The Pines Car Show that raised \$2,700 which will help cover operating costs in 2023. The Bereavement Ministry counseled those who have lost a loved one during a challenging year with COVID.

The ladies of the Funeral Ministry prepared and served food for luncheons following 3 funerals—more than 100 mourners. We supported a student through Unbound by funding his school tuition. We cleaned sorted, painted and decorated our new Madonna Room using our own labor and zero dollars from our bank account. We served refreshments at the summer lecture series in July & August.

The Thanksgiving Ministry fed a couple hundred people in our community via donations by our parishioners. The Christmas Stocking Ministries sewed, decorated and collected stocking stuffers for over 300 stockings (100 more than last year!) which will be distributed to the needy in our community. We have a new online Newsletter.

The Outreach Ministry recruited many new members. The new Library Ministry is set to open a religious books library early next year. We will distribute 500 copies of <u>Holy Moments</u> to parishioners FREE.

Wow! What a year we have had! I could not be more proud of YOU!
