Daily Reflections on Divine Mercy with Saint Faustina

Reflection 22: Abundant Mercy Stretching Your Soul

Encountering Jesus in your soul will have the effect of leading you to long for more. Do you long for more of Jesus? Do you long for His Mercy? The desire for Him, the desire for more, stretches us and enables us to receive more of His Mercy every day. Let the desire for our Lord grow in abundance within you.

Spend time, this day, looking at your heart. Is it daily being stretched by the abundant Mercy of God? Do you see your soul being filled each day to the point that it feels like bursting with gratitude and overflowing with love? If not, know that God wants to pour this abundance of Mercy into your life.

Lord, I am open to You and Your Mercy. But I know there is so much more that You wish to pour out upon me. I know You desire to fill my soul with Your grace to such an abundance that it overflows with love of You and with love for others. Help me to be open to this abundance of Your love and Mercy. Jesus, I trust in You.



Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. The liturgical celebrations for this day may be the "Mass For Giving Thanks to God for the Gift of Human Life".

Nine Days for Life is an annual novena for the protection of human life. Each day's intention is accompanied by a short reflection and suggested actions to help build a culture of life. Arizona law allows you, as a taxpayer, to direct your Arizona state tax liability to School Tuition Organizations such as Catholic Education Arizona. This is a dollar-for-dollar tax credit against what you owe the State of Arizona. The funds are used exclusively for the cost of tuition at private schools which include our Diocesan Catholic Schools. **For 2022 you may redirect any portion of your tax liability up to these maximum amounts: (1/1/22-4/18/2023) \$1,243 for single filers or \$2,483 for married fillers.** Brochures are in the Church lobby and Parish Office.
