MORE FUNDRAISING IN 2023!

As the Madonna Guild continues to grow in active members, we have been able to take on more and diverse ministries that enrich and support our parish family and local community. This translates into additional costs.


To alleviate the additional costs associated with our expanded ministries, the Madonna Guild will host two craft fairs on the Church property this year. The craft fairs, called "Made On The Mountain", will be on Saturday, July 15th in the Church Overflow Hall and on Saturday, November 4th in the SJFC. Both events will run from 9am - 2pm. The July 15th craft fair in the Church Overflow Hall will have approximately 20 10' x 10' spaces costing \$30 each. First come first served. We ask each vendor who participates to donate an item of at least \$25 value for our raffle during the event.

The November 4th craft fair in the SJFC will be able to accommodate many more vendors. Pricing will be the same.

Terry also plans to hold our annual bake sale on Saturday, September 23rd at the Run To The Pines Car Show in Pinetop.

Terry is really going to keep us all busy this year!


