FUNDRAISING IN 2023 NEEDS YOU!



COMMUNITY OUTREACH SPOTLIGHT —LIVING HOPE DREAM CENTERS

I recently had an opportunity to attend a Liaison Meeting with Brandon Todd, Donor Development Director, with Living Hope Dream Centers and came away with a wealth of information. Living Hope Dream Centers was founded in 1997 by founder Dinah Monhan with some highly motivated and dedicated people in her church. Living Hope helps mothers to have their baby rather than to choose abortion.

Today, Living Hope has grown to three Pregnancy Resource Centers (PRC located in Show Low, Springerville, and Whiteriver), a Thrift Store, and most importantly a Maternity Home.

Living Hope is a 501(c)(3) funded by private donations and is faith-based Their services are free because of a generous and supportive community (individuals, other faith-based churches, and local businesses).

What exactly does Living Hope Dream Centers offer? It's all in the name... Hope and Dreams! Hope and dreams begin with outreach and support. List below is a breakdown of the services provided for free:

The Pregnancy Resource Center:

- pregnancy testing
- information regarding pregnancy options with trained advocates
- post-abortion support (for women who arrive after having already had an abortion)
- adoption information and support
- ultrasounds performed by medical professionals •
- classes on what to expect from pregnancy to how to maintain a budget
- Baby Boutique with access to diapers, clothes, furniture, and other baby supplies

Hope House Maternity Home was created to ensure a safe place for pregnant mothers to stay if they are homeless or do not have a support system in place. The home can house up to four mothers at a time.

What's incredible and unique to this program is no limit is placed on a mother's stay and she can bring her children with her. The mothers are mentored by staff and volunteers to set goals for themselves, learn life skills, start a savings account, and a part-time job at the Thrift Store. This ensures each participant in the program receives on-the-job training, builds a resume, and most importantly receives income to put into savings. The program requires the mothers to place 80% of their paycheck into savings. The earn as you learn classes provides "Boutique Bucks" which can be used at the Baby Boutique for items (diapers, furniture, maternity clothes, infant clothes). The Maternity Home mentors and staff are truly setting up these young mothers for success!

The More you Know get the word out! Little Caesars and Kentucky Fried Chicken have partnered with Living Hope Dream Centers to ensure zero food waste. What does this mean? Every Monday and Thursday leftover food from Little Caesars is distributed to the public. Every Friday leftover food from Kentucky Fried Chicken is distributed to the public. The free food distribution begins at 10 AM on Monday, Thursday, and Friday at Hopeful Treasures Boutique located at 1901 E. Deuce of Clubs, Show Low until the food is gone.
