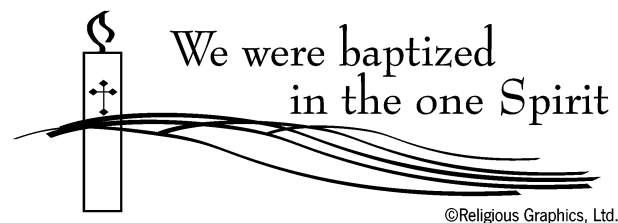


Pentecost Sunday

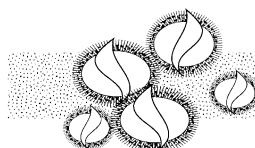




Community Information
