## OLD BUSINESS

It is possible there will be additional participants from other parishes.

Margie brought Father Dan's list, 'Lent, One Deed at a Time'. Father requested the Madonna Guild provide several spiritual and practical suggestions. The list was completed at the end of the meeting.

<u>Community Outreach Ministry:</u> Arleen was not in attendance. Katherine explained that this ministry encompasses all community focused activities such as Christmas Stockings, Thanksgiving Baskets, Angel Tree Program, as well as which community organizations receive these donations.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

<u>Update of Chair and Co-chairs:</u> Katherine provided an updated list of Ministry Chairs and Co-chairs. (Page 6 of the newsletter, Sherry Mannikko and Linda Dodson added to Social Activities)

**Update of Member list:** Katherine provided an updated list of Madonna Guild Members.

Dorota requested that members review list and notify her if any changes are needed. It was requested that the member list indicate full time or summer resident.

<u>Elections:</u> Katherine reported that traditionally elections have been very relaxed, but considering that we are now a group of 90+ members Bernie suggested there be some standardized rules or dates established for the annual officer and ministry elections. It was suggested that we may need an official person not affiliated with any office or ministry who would regulate the elections. Candidates have historically never had any opponents, so if someone wants a particular office they have been welcomed by all members. It was agreed that elections/voting should not take place at a party. It was also agreed that only full-time residents are eligible to hold an office. It was agreed that in September notification of elections will be announced. In

October members are to make the guild aware of their interest. And voting will take place in November at the monthly meeting.
