In December, these 300 stockings will be loaded with up with all kinds of useful goodies and treats donated by the Madonna Guild and by our generous parishioners. These stockings will then be donated to organizations within our community such as: Meals On Wheels, Walking Down Ranch (for veterans), the Senior Center and to our sister organization at the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Bii'Nalwod.

Rosary Ministry

Dorothy Dobry reports that the latest box of rosaries was delivered to churches in Nigeria by our flight attendant friend, Mary Ann Lynch.

The following is expenditures for rosary making supplies by year and how many rosaries were made.

2020 \$249 1,583 rosaries

2021 \$251 1,490 rosaries

2022 \$523 3,270 rosaries

2023 \$233 1,930 rosaries YTD

That is a total of 8,273 rosaries made in less than 4 years!

We have a couple of rosary makers who buy their own supplies but their number of rosaries made are included in the totals above.

If you would like to learn to make rosaries, Dorothy Dobry would love to teach you. Rosaries are easy and fun to make.

Dorothy has written instructions for you to follow and she can spend a few minutes with you to get you started.

Dorothy will provide the supplies for free. All you need is a little free time and a pair of scissors.

What better way to honor Our Lady and to fill some of your spare time!


