A YEAR OF GIVING TO THOSE IN NEED!

It takes a loving heart and loads of compassion to help those around us. St Teresa of Avila wrote “Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which He looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which He blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are his body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours.”


You emulate those heartfelt words through the Madonna ministries in which you participate. In 2023, the wonderful ladies of the Rosary Ministry made 3,030 rosaries that have been flown to Churches throughout the world and are given away in an Arizona prison ministry. The compassionate ladies of the Prayer Shawl Ministry crocheted 106 large shawls and about 300 pocket shawls to comfort the sick and help heal the grieving. These shawls have gone to family, friends and neighbors far and wide.

Our Blood Drive Ministry provided life-saving blood and blood products to a couple hundred recipients. The Community Outreach Ministry fed hundreds of poor in our community during the Thanksgiving holiday; stocked the shelves at a neighborhood free grocery for the poor; will distribute over 300 Christmas stockings brimming with toiletries & Christmas candy; and is now amassing sheets, blankets, etc. to keep a retirement facility, run by the Little Sisters of the Poor in Gallup, NM, well-stocked.

Our Book Study Ministry offered classes throughout this year to deepen the faith of God’s faithful. The Bereavement Ministry counselled the grieving. The Correspondence Ministry kept in touch with a student we sponsor in Uganda and paid for his tuition. The Funeral Luncheon Ministry provided a delicious and comforting lunch for the grieving following some funeral Masses.

The ladies of the Library Ministry transformed a little-used room into a beautiful library filled with religious books, donated by our parishioners, to deepen our faith. The Prayer Line Ministry offered fervent prayers for those in need. The Social Activities Ministry celebrated our year-round and summer parishioners with a Tea and a Parish Potluck as well as welcomed new Madonna members at our Meet & Greets. Our Madonna Ambassador found new members who would help us help others. And, finally, our Fundraising Committee raised a whopping \$7,903.61 to fund our ministries to do this all over again next year!

Have we, as Madonna members, honored Our Lady and been faithful to the words of St Teresa of Avila? You decide.

CRAFT FAIR & BAKE SALE A HUGE SUCCESS!



Talking about money is rarely a pleasant conversation these days. This IS, however, a happy topic for the Madonna Guild right now. Due to the **HARD WORK** of our fundraising chair, Terry Linn, and her team, the November Made On The Mountain Craft Fair & Bake Sale raised \$3,587.06!! Special thanks also goes to Tess Durfee who ran a **VERY** successful 50/50 raffle during the craft fair!

Let's look at the fundraising throughout this year. Our first ever Made On The Mountain Craft Fair & Bake Sale in July netted \$1,126. The Run To The Pines Bake Sale in September raised \$3,190.55. Add those to the November Made On The Mountain proceeds of \$3,587.06 and the Fundraising Ministry put a total of \$7,903.61 into our accounts! As you know, this money is instrumental to continue our ministries in 2024. A heartfelt thank you to all the ladies who worked tirelessly to raise these funds!

The next prayer shawl meeting will be Thursday, December 7th at 10am in the Madonna Room.




THANKSGIVING FOOD A DELICIOUS SUCCESS!
