Putting Our Fundraising in Focus!

At our July meeting, the ladies of the Madonna Guild voted to focus most of our fundraising efforts on our successful Made On The Mountain Craft Fair & Bake Sale.

What this means for the Madonna Guild going forward is that we are going to increase the craft fairs from one day events to two day events falling on a Friday and Saturday in May and November of each year. As well, the hours each day will be expanded to 9am to 4pm to give ample time for people in our community to visit and to shop.

We will no longer participate in the Run To The Pines Car Show where in the past we have sold our homemade baked goods. We will, however, continue to sell our delicious pies, cobblers, muffins, fruit breads, brownies, etc., at the Made On The Mountain Craft Fair & Bake Sales. Our next craft fair is November 8th/9th, 2024 (see flier page 9).

This change allows us to eliminate having to move large quantities of setup equipment as well as our baked goods off the Church campus and also eliminates the challenge of keeping our baked goods cool outdoors in the summer heat.

As far as what we plan to use our fundraising dollars on, we plan to continue to support and/or expand our many ministries (see the list on page 7), to support our parish by helping to fund property and facility improvements, and to expand our contribution to local worthwhile charities in the community such as Catholic Charities in Lakeside, White Mountain Villas in Show Low (low income housing), Walking Down Ranch in Lakeside (veterans), and the RE Center in Pinetop (free meal program).

As a matter of fact, the Madonnas voted to donate **\$10,000** of our funds to pay for the materials to replace damaged siding on the east side of the Church building.

So when you see us fundraising, now you know the judicious way in which we use those funds!

Chaplain Lungu requested more rosaries be sent to his prison ministry in Florence, AZ.


If you would like to learn to make rosaries, Dorothy would love to teach you. Rosaries are easy and fun to make!
