## Madonna Guild News

### We Served Our Church & Community More In 2024!

Thank you for the tremendous amount of work YOU did to support our Church and our White Mountain community in 2024! The Madonna Guild:

- distributed 132 handmade prayer shawls/lap robes and 225 pocket shawls to provide comfort to patients at the Summit Cancer Center, to local nursing homes and to individuals in need.
- distributed 6,038 handmade rosaries to the Florence, AZ prison and to churches throughout the world
- donated \$3,000 to St Francis Church in White River, AZ
- operated two blood drives to collect life-saving blood products
- prepared and served numerous funeral luncheons throughout the year to help grieving families
- distributed locally 300+ handmade Christmas stockings brimming with personal care products, a rosary, and candy to Catholic Charities, Walking
  Down Ranch (veterans), Meals on Wheels, and White Mountain Villas (low-income housing)
- donated \$10,000 in materials and paint for the exterior upkeep of our Church building
- presented religious book & video study classes throughout the year
- celebrated Father Dan Daley's 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary at St Mary's Church with a Parish Potluck
- gifted 500 books at Christmas to parishioners and to summer residents
- with the help of our parishioners, we donated supplies to the nursing home run by Little Sisters of the Poor in Gallup, NM
- distributed the fixings for Thanksgiving meals to our local community
- paid school tuition for a teenager in Uganda
- stocked and operated a religious library for our parishioners
- welcomed year-round and summer visitors with a Summer Tea


