





Monday, September B, 2025

Phoenix, Tlaquepaque, Guadalajara

We will depart from Phoenix on flight AA6202 at 8:30 a.m., arriving in Guadalajara at 12:35 p.m. After clearing Immigration and Customs, we will exit to meet our Adriatic Tours Representative. From there, we will drive to the beautiful town ofT!aquepaque for a panoramic tour before continuing to Guadalajara for dinner and an overnight stay.

Tuesday, September 9, 2025

Guadalajara, Zapopan, San Juan de los Lagos, Cristo Rey, Guanajuato

This morning, we will visit the Church of Our Lady of Zapopan, followed by a drive to San Juan de los Lagos to see the main Cathedral. We will then continue to the Cerro de! Cubilete to view the impressive statue of Cristo Rey (Christ the King). Our journey concludes in Guanajuato, known for its grand colonial architecture. The Pipila Monument, set on a hillside, offers a breathtaking panorama of the city and surrounding hills.

Wednesday, September 10, 2025

Guanajuato, San Miguel de Allende, Mexico City

We will depart for San Miguel de Allende, a charming city known for its cobblestone streets, vibrant Z6calo framed by a stunning 17th-century Gothic church, historic buildings, inviting cafes, and numerous art galleries. Later, we will continue to Mexico City for our overnight stay.

Thursday, September 11, 2025

Teotihuacan, □mids, Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe

This morning, we will travel to Teotihuacan, one of Mexico's best-preserved ancient cities and once the most important city in North America. Highlights include the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon, and the mile-long Avenue of the Dead, framed by numerous monuments and structures. In the afternoon, we will

visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, including the Basilica that Mouses the sacred image of the Virgin (Tilma), the old Basilica, and Tepeyac Hill.

Friday, September 12, 2025

Xochimilco, Mexico City

We will travel to Xochimilco and enjoy a traditional boat ride with entertainment by Mariachi musicians. Afterward, we return to Mexico City for a panoramic tour, including the Plaza of the Three Cultures, the Z6calo, and the Metropolitan Cathedral.

Saturday, September 13, 2025

Taxco, Cuernavaca

Today, we take a scenic drive to Cuernavaca, known as the "City of Eternal Spring." We will explore its vibrant market and church area with beautiful gardens. Later, we continue to the silver- mining town of Taxco, nestled in the Sierra Madre mountains. We will stroll through the cobblestone streets and visit Santa Prisca Church, known for its Baroque altarpieces. Free time for shopping will be provided.

Sunday, September 14, 2025 Puebla, Tlaxcala, Ocotlan

Today, we will visit Puebla, showcasing its remarkable Spanish colonial architecture. We will explore the Cathedral and the Church of Santo Domingo, home to the exquisite Rosary Chapel, where we will celebrate Mass. Next, we travel to San Miguel de! Milagro in Tlaxcala. In the afternoon, we continue to Ocotlan to visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Ocotlan, where an apparition of Juan Diego was miraculously imprinted into the trunk of an oak tree.

We will depart Puebla for Mexico City Airport to board flight AA502 at 3:25 p.m., arriving in Phoenix at 5:50 p.m.
