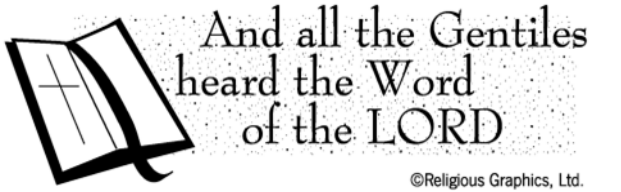


Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

Acts of the Apostles 12:1-11
Psalm 34: 2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9
2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18
Matthew 16:13-19



Today’s Theme: Peter, rescued from the power of Herod, and Paul, protected from his enemies, proclaim with their lives that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God.

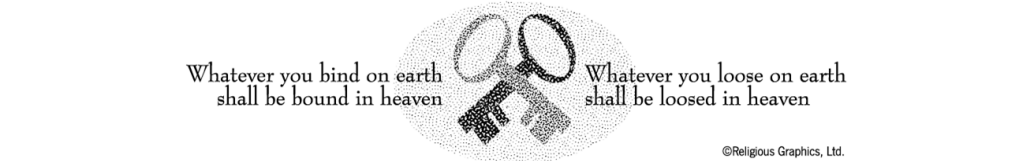
