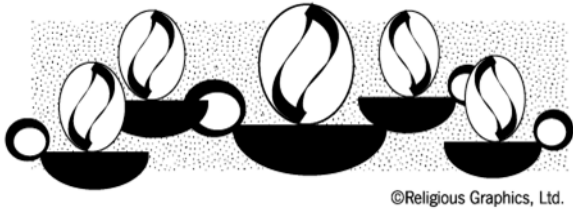


Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Today’s Theme:** *The Lord came to the aid of Jeremiah, whose preaching brought upon him rejection and ill treatment. Like Christ, we must never grow despondent or abandon the struggle to proclaim and live the truth.*



**Vigilance, Attentiveness, Action** – Reflect, today, upon the call from God to always be attentive to His voice the instant He speaks. 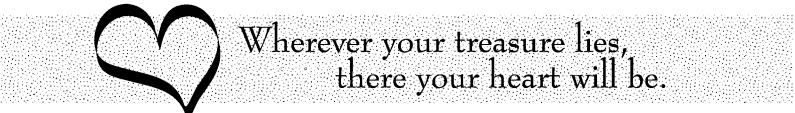
