God So Loved the World

Having ended the weeks of Lent and the Easter season, the fifty days after Easter Sunday, with the feast of Pentecost, God has revealed definitively Himself to the world as Creator, Redeemer and Sanctifier. For centuries, God insisted to His people Israel that He is One. There is only one God and He alone we must love with all our hearts.



This One God is, however, a community of persons. It would not be possible for us to come to this conclusion, if God had not revealed it to us, that God is one in nature but three in Persons. The Son of God, made man in Jesus Christ, is in fact one with the Father. The Father and the Son are so in love with one another that they give

rise to the third Person, the Holy Spirit. Jesus, the Son of God, was revealed in His birth and especially in His death and resurrection, the Holy Spirit was fully revealed in Pentecost. Just as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are also eternal and have been at work since the beginning of time. Over the chaotic water at the beginning of creation hovered the "spirit of the Lord". The Word of the Father was creative and all things that are, exist because of Jesus Christ, the Word of God.

John gives us the beautiful and famous words that "God so loved the world so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life." God did not create us to condemn us. There will come a time of judgement in the end, but until then we live in this time when the Father sent us His Son to redeem us and sent His Holy Spirit to sanctify us and unite us in Him.

The love that unites the Trinity is a love of obedience to the will of the Father. This we see very clearly in Jesus' words and actions. The Holy Spirit was sent to us to help us to know and be obedient to the will of the Father. This loving obedience in turn keeps us in union with the Divine Trinity always. Let us do all in the name of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
