Fear No One

Fear is often used to manipulate and motivate people into action. We see it all around us in the media today. Fear for our health, for our financial security, for our physical security and so much more. Obviously, we should be prudent and intelligent in our actions and take the precautions that are



necessary to avoid danger, but we should not act - much less be paralyzed - by fear. St. Paul reminds us in Romans 8:39 that nothing can separate us from the love of God. If God is with us, what or who can be against us?

Have a Blessed Father's Day!

Jesus gives us this lesson in the Gospel today: that we are to fear no one. Not only are we are too often motivated by fear, but we fear the wrong things. We fear the loss of material things, our health or even what people might think of us. What we should truly fear, is often what the world makes light of, and what the world scoffs at, is often what Jesus asks us to do. Jesus tells us to fear the one who can send us into hell. What will send us into the eternal fire? Sin.

Some say that Jesus is speaking of Satan, since He uses the words "him who can destroy both body and soul". I would rather

suggest however that we be not even fearful of the devil but respect and be very leery of his ability to lead us into sin. It is sin itself that can “destroy both body and soul in hell”. I say this firstly because temptation to sin can come from within us. We do not need the devil in order to tempted. Our concupiscence, or sinful desires, are rooted in our own wounded human nature. The devil, when he is involved, tempts us subtly and many times without us knowing it, since his goal is not for us to fear him but to fall into sin. I say we should not be fearful of the devil since even he can only harm us at most externally and cannot take us into hell unless we fall into despair. Jesus gives us the power to cast out demons; He does not want us to cower before them. He does want us to resist sin – even to the point of shedding our blood.

Jesus today is asking us to have the courage of the martyrs, who resisted evil; the audacity of the saints who proclaimed to the world the truth of the Gospel despite rejection; the bravery of those who engage, each and every day, in the spiritual combat that is our Christian life. Jesus is our strength. Fear no one but sin.
